## ABOUT AFFORDABLE ART FAIR:

The very first edition of the Affordable Art Fair took place in London's Battersea Park in October 1999. Ten thousand art lovers descended upon the fair to browse and buy thousands of original contemporary paintings, sculptures, photographs and prints in a relaxed and friendly environment. They now hold fairs in 10 cities around the world including London, New York, Hong Kong, Hamburg, Amsterdam, Brussels, Singapore, Stockholm, Melbourne and Sydney, with three new fairs launching in 2024 – Austin, Berlin and Brisbane. Each year they welcome nearly 220,000 art enthusiasts to their fairs globally, where visitors can discover a mix of local, national and international galleries showcasing a wide array of affordable artworks by established artists and rising stars.

Each edition of the fair is filled with a creative smorgasbord of artist performances, innovative talks and tours, hands-on workshops, kid's activities, live music and irresistible restaurants and bars; making them an ideal day out with family and friends. Since its humble beginnings, over 3.3 million people have visited an Affordable Art Fair around the world, taking home over 600,000 pieces of artwork to loving new homes.

Alongside New York City, Austin will be the only other fair location in the United States. Affordable Art Fair selected Austin based on its already vibrant local art and music scene, the lack of any other art fairs in the city, and the strong demand for exciting contemporary art coming from a burgeoning group of collectors, buyers, and art lovers.

Since 2016, Koslov Larsen (formerly Foto Relevance) cofounders Geoffrey C. Koslov and Bryn Larsen have focused on the exhibition and acquisition of museum-quality, contemporary fine art photography and photography-based work. Joined by Zan Zeller in 2019 who currently leads the program as Assistant Director, Koslov Larsen is dedicated to providing a platform for an innovative selection of American and international photographic artists pushing the boundaries of photography. In addition to promoting the work of artists, Koslov Larsen provides guidance, educating individual collectors and corporations in the acquisition and sale of art. Koslov Larsen is a member of the Association of International Photography Art Dealers (AIPAD) and the Houston Art Gallery Association (HAGA). The gallery is located in the historic Museum District in Houston, Texas in close proximity to the Museum of Fine Arts, Houston, the Menil Collection, and the Houston Center for Photography.
